Boroughwide Locations

ABC to Read (Assisting Berkshire Children)

(Support primary school children to improve their reading ability.)

- Project** Making cards to sell for fundraising (Birthday, Christmas & General).
Arranging a Volunteers Coffee Morning for volunteers in WAM area.

RBWM CHILDREN'S CENTRES

(Education, activities and groups for young children. Also run breakfast and after school clubs.)

ADULT DYSLEXIA CENTRE

- Project** To decorate the tired looking interior of our centre and create a bright and welcoming space again. Materials provided.

BRAYWICK NATURE CENTRE

(A local Nature Reserve which also operates as an Education Centre working with local schools to teach children about their environment.)

- Project** To help improve the woodlands for wildlife by felling and sawing trees, stacking logs into habitat piles and planting saplings and bulbs. (Nov – Mar activities).

CITIZENS ADVICE MAIDENHEAD & WINDSOR

(Provide free, impartial and independent advice to Borough residents on many problems including housing, employment, debt, benefits, etc. We also issue Foodshare vouchers for the area.)

Project To organise and run a Thank You Event (eg Quiz Night & Supper) for 40 Volunteers

HORSE RANGERS, FIFIELD

(Use rescue Horses to teach children with no access to ponies all aspects of riding and care of the animals. Use a structured programme where children earn badges as they pass stages.)

Project Land clearance, land and building maintenance, building fences etc.

MAIDENHEAD COMMUNITY CENTRE

(Day Centre services and activities for the elderly.)

Projects Various land and building maintenance projects (gardening/mowing, painting/decorating, litter picking)

MAIDENHEAD FOODSHARE/OPEN KITCHEN

(Centre for the Homeless, and supply food/meals to people in need)

Projects Collecting/Sorting/Delivering food items, helping with meals at Centre

MAIDENHEAD FESTIVAL

(Takes place in Kidwells Park in July, and has attendance of around 8,000 people.)

Project Teams to help with set-up/directing & assisting stall holders/chair hire/backstage. (NB In recognition, your COMPANY LOGO would be displayed on website and big screen at Festival)

MAIDENHEAD SOCIAL WORK TEAM

(Looking after vulnerable local residents who have special support needs)

Project Paint a small one bedroom flat for a Learning Disabled Client

NATIONAL TRUST CLIVEDEN / MAIDENHEAD & COOKHAM COMMON

Project Land clearance and maintenance, planting, hedging, ditching, digging, etc

RBWM CHILDREN'S CENTRES

(Education, activities and groups for young children. Also run breakfast and after school clubs.)

- Project** Room and Garden makeover or maintenance projects at local Children's Centres.

SALVATION YOUTH TRUST

(Bringing practical skills experience and opportunities to young people)
